

#### History of Alpha Phi Alpha Fraternity, Inc.

Since it's founding on Tuesday, December 4, 1906, Alpha Phi Alpha Fraternity, Inc. has supplied voice and vision to the struggle of African-Americans and people of color around the world. Alpha Phi Alpha (AΦA), the first intercollegiate Greek-letter fraternity established for African-Americans, was founded at Cornell University in Ithaca, New York by seven college men who recognized the need for a strong bond of Brotherhood among African descendants in this country. The visionary founders, known as the Jewels of the Fraternity, are Henry Arthur Callis, Charles Henry Chapman, Eugene Kinckle Jones, George Biddle Kelley, Nathaniel Allison Murray, Robert Harold Ogle, and Vertner Woodson Tandy.



The Fraternity initially served as a study and support group for minority students who faced racial prejudice, both educationally and socially, at Cornell. The Jewel founders and early leaders of the Fraternity succeeded in laying a firm foundation for Alpha Phi Alpha's principles of scholarship, fellowship, good character, and the uplifting of humanity.

Alpha Phi Alpha chapters were established at other colleges and universities, many of them historically black institutions, soon after the founding at Cornell. The first Alumni Chapter was established in 1911. While continuing to stress academic excellence among its members, Alpha also recognized the need to help correct the educational, economic, political, and social injustices faced by African-Americans.

Alpha Phi Alpha has long stood at the forefront of the African-American community's fight for civil rights through leaders such as: W.E.B. DuBois, Adam Clayton Powell, Jr., Edward Brooke, Martin Luther King, Jr., Thurgood Marshall, Andrew Young, William Gray, Paul Robeson, Ralph Metcalfe, Sr., Ernest Morial, and many others. True to its form as the "of firsts," Alpha Phi Alpha has been interracial since 1945.

Alpha Phi Alpha today continues its commitment to members of the Fraternity and the African-American community through Alpha University. Through the groundbreaking Alpha University training program, the Fraternity has rededicated itself to fostering a spirit of Brotherhood within the ranks of the Fraternity, preparing a new generation of leaders and bringing consistency to chapter operation and to the implementation of the Fraternity's National and Special programs.

First of All, Servants of All, We Shall Transcend All.

### A Brief History of the Kappa Upsilon Lambda (ΚΥΛ) Chapter

Kappa Upsilon Lambda Chapter, the 542th Chapter of Alpha Phi Alpha Fraternity, Incorporated, was chartered on the Tuesday, December 3, 1974, by fourteen men in the Mid-Hudson Valley area of New York in order to continue their commitment to the Fraternity and its motto. Our mission is to help young black males graduate high school and inspire them to become productive citizens through a college education. Our services also include educating our communities on the importance of voting and practicing abstinence.

The Kappa Upsilon Lambda Chapter serves the New York Mid-Hudson Valley area and it's surroundings including the Towns and Cities of Poughkeepsie, Newburgh, Fishkill, Beacon, Wappinger Falls, and Middletown.

The Chapter and it's charitable arm, the KUL Foundation, sponsor and support a growing number of mentorship, giveback, and scholarship programs throughout the Mid-Hudson Valley of New York. These include our premiere mentorship program, the **Project Thunder Program**, as well as the **CHRIS Foundation**, participation **LDI or Leadership Development Institutes**; and our newly established scholarship program, the *Christopher Scudder Memorial Scholarship Fund*. Through Project Thunder, and the Chapter and the Foundation, the Chapter implements and provides financial support for the Fraternity's National and Special Programs: "Go-To-High School, Go-To-College", and "Project Alpha". The Chapter looks to grow its charitable giving and community reach through endowments from Corporate and Community Partners and Sponsors.

After a far too long hiatus, in 2009 the Chapter re-established and held it's prestigious **Black & Gold Gala**, a black-tie event used to recognize distinguished individuals and organizations in the Mid-Hudson Valley for their charitable works. It is held every 5 years now. In 2014, the Chapter and the Foundation established the Scholarship Dinner Dance. It is their signature annual event and also serves as a premiere fundraiser with local business sponsorship and your financial support. It provides the Chapter and the Foundation the funding to continue to deliver and expand our top quality mentoring, youth outreach, and community service initiatives, that help build self-esteem, promote career development, inspire good citizenship and civic responsibility, and show the importance of obtaining a college education.


# The Brother Richard F. Peterson Memorial Scholarship

The Brother Richard F. Peterson Memorial Scholarship is given in honor of one of Kappa Upsilon Lambda Chapter's Most Honored Founders who touched the lives of countless thousands of over the years through his generosity and benevolence. Upon Brother "Dickie" Peterson's untimely passing on Monday, May 23, 2016, the Alumni Brothers of Rho Omicron (United States Military Academy at West Point, NY) established the Memorial Scholarship in honor and in gratitude for the part that Brother Peterson played in the establishment of the Chapter and to continue



Brother Peterson's annual commitment to bestow a monetary award to a high scholastic achieving (3.78 or above/4.00 (i.e. 94.5% and above)), college-bound, graduating Senior of minority descent.

### The Brother Nelson A. Keyes Memorial Scholarship



The Brother Nelson A. Keyes Memorial Scholarship was established in April 2017 in honor of Brother Nelson A. Keyes who passed away one year before on March 24, 2016. Brother Keyes was initiated into the Fraternity through Kappa Upsilon Lambda Chapter in the Spring of 1996. He would later become a Life Member of the Fraternity and worked to instill and inspire in others the fortitude to pursue excellence in all areas of life ...including the class room, in sports field, and/or service to the communities in which we live. Must have a 3.78 or above/4.00.

Since May 2017, both Scholarships are now being funded under the KUL Foundation's **Christopher J. Scudder Memorial Scholarship Fund**. The awards are competitive. Applicants must have a minimum of an "A" average AND a strong list of verifiable community service activity and accomplishments.


